Hailing from Allahabad, he soared to sporting heights as an Olympian at the 2004 Athens Olympics and etched his legacy in the Limca Book of Records as India's first shuttler to conquer National Championships in all categories. Transitioning seamlessly, in 1999, he embraced a new frontier as he joined IndianOil. Today, as Chief Manager (Quality Control), Allahabad Terminal, he monitors JetA1 product quality for aviation, exemplifying the same unwavering commitment to excellence that marked his sporting career.
