He also clinched two National mixed-doubles titles with Manjusha Kanwar. Notably, Mr Jaseel, in partnership with V Diju, secured the doubles title at the Indian Asian Satellite 2004 in Hyderabad.

In his own words, "Being a regular member of the Indian teams at the Thomas Cup and the World Championships is a source of enduring pride." His unwavering self-confidence and commitment to representing the nation have propelled him to greatness.

Glorious moments in Sports

- Silver medal from the Prime Minister of Malaysia in the 1998 commonwealth games at Kuala Lumpur.
