Manika began playing table tennis at the tender age of four. She was recruited in 2015 and became part of IndianOil Scholarship program. She etched history by becoming the first Indian woman to win a singles gold medal at the 2018 Commonwealth Games and earned recognition for her stellar performances at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

- Represented India at the Rio Olympics - 2016, Tokyo Olympics - 2020, & Paris Olympics - 2024.
- Became the first Indian TT woman to break into the top 25 of the world rankings, 2024.
- Won Gold at Asian Table Tennis Championships, 2024.
- Won two Gold, one Silver & one Bronze at Gold Coast Commonwealth Games, 2018.
- Won three Gold & one Silver at South Asian Games, 2016.
- Bestowed with Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award - 2020, Arjuna Award -2018, ITTF Star Award -2018 & Indian Sports Honour - 2019.
